The District Court issued its Opinion and Order on March 29, 2024, and its

in March 2006. This Court entered an Order on Remand Granting in Part Defendant's Motion to

Dismiss on September 16, 2024. Based on the record in this adversary proceeding, including the

Decision, IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Motion to Dismiss is granted as to the claim concerning the purported transfer

of \$100,000,000.00 in March 2006.

2. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to implement or enforce this Order.
